3 Most Important things to remember today

- **Children must wear a properly fitted, U.S. Coast Guard approved life jacket at all times when on a dock or boat. No exceptions.**
- **Children must be accompanied by their parent/guardian at all times. The parent is responsible for the child during the entire event. Separation for any length of time will not be permitted, including bathroom breaks. Volunteers should never be alone with a child during the event.**
- **Everyone must check-in at the registration table. A registration form must be on file either online or on paper.**

Other Reminders for the day:

1. Please be aware of the perimeter of the event. (Define the perimeter for fishing as well as the perimeter for where the shore activities will take place.) _____.
2. Volunteers must stay aware of their surroundings to reduce risks to children. Immediately report hazards or dangers concerning the safety of the children with special needs to the event coordinator.
3. We want you to fish as well as the child, hand-offs are great.
4. No swimming should take place during the event.
5. Lunch will be at _____. Please return from the water on time. The latest you should be back is_____.
6. Here is the coordinator's phone number. _____ Please call if you have any issues while with your fishing buddy. In case of a medical emergency, please call 911.
